

# Pavilion to Become Theater-in-Round

"The Pavilion Theater," once mere wishful thinking on the part of the theater arts department, will become a long-awaited reality in two months.

Conversion of the Stock Judging Pavilion to a theater-in-the-round for use by the Department of Theater Arts is scheduled to be completed by Dec. 5, Walter H. Walters, department head, said recently.

Alteration of the pavilion, located on Curtin Road across from the Creamery, is the first step in the campus arts and humanities building project.

WALTERS SAID present plans call for the new structure to have a seating capacity of 320. The stage will be located in the center of the arena-shaped building and seating areas will surround the stage on all four sides.

"This arrangement will be challenging but we are looking forward to working on it," he said. According to present plans, one

end of the building will serve as an area for preparation of sets, while the opposite end will be used as a lobby.

THE ENTRANCE will be located, slightly above the last row of seats, thus requiring patrons to descend in order to reach their seats.

The principal advantage of the new theater will be its flexibility, Walters said.

Structural features of the building, which will promote such flexibility include:

- A movable seating unit on risers, which can be removed when not in use. These seats, when removed, will provide additional space for certain scenes that require it.

- Two elevated platforms adjacent to the stage proper, which will aid in presenting complicated scenes. These platforms will be

valuable in scenes which depict action occurring above the normal stage level.

- A trap door in one area of the main stage. This device will permit scenes in which a character rises to the stage level from a point beneath it.

The grand opening of the theater is scheduled for next spring.
