

Sewage Plant Expansion Scheduled

Bids are now being accepted for construction of an addition to the University Sewage Plant, Stanley H. Campbell, vice president for business administration, said recently. The deadline for bids is Oct. 25. A contract should be awarded and construction begun shortly after that time, he added. Campbell said the addition should increase the present plant's capacity by 75 per cent. The reason for the addition, Campbell said, is because of the expected enrollment increase of the University.

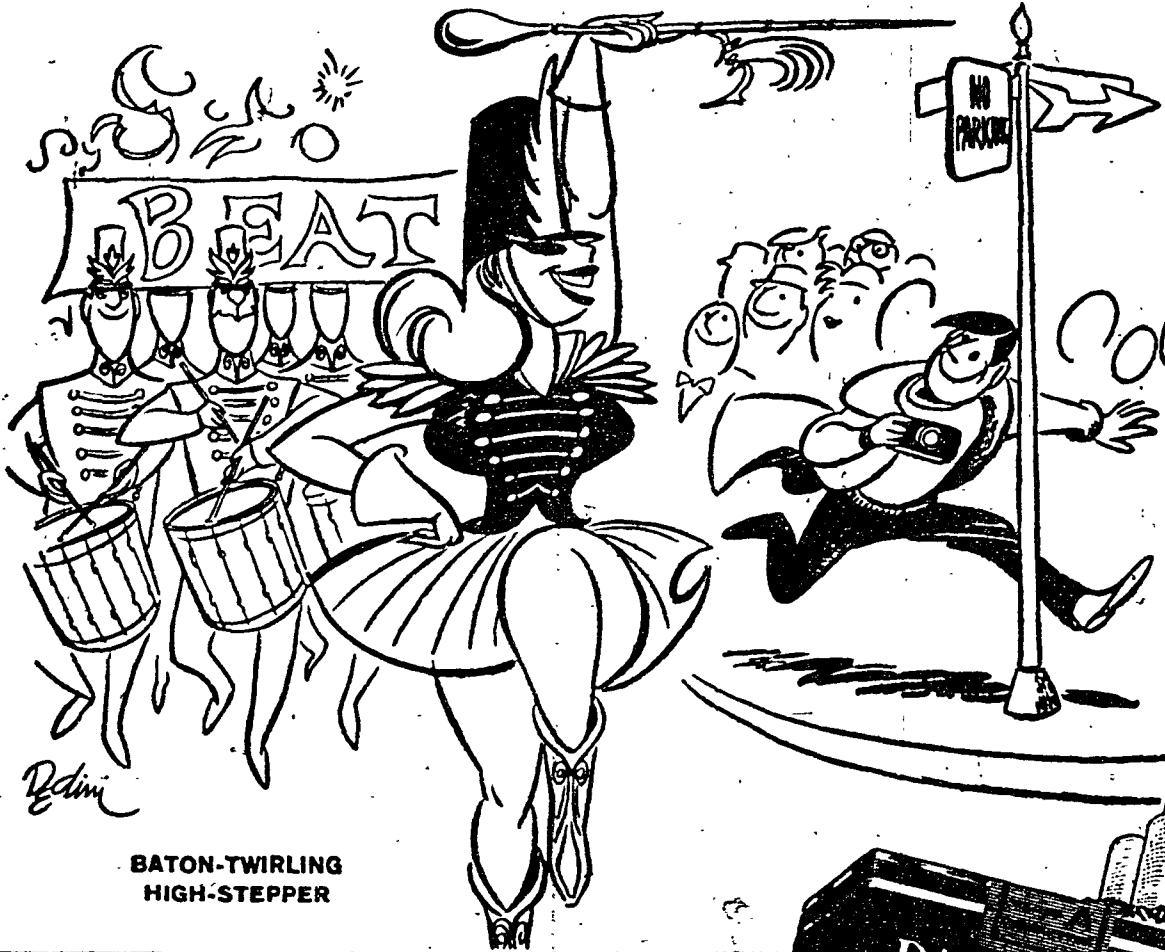
