Albert Magnotta, spokesman for the group, presented the following statement to The Daily Collegian:

"The houses that met tonight feel that some kind of humor magazine has a place at the Pennsylvania State University. We will recommend to IFC (In-

terfraternity Council) that the IFC throw its full weight behind a completely revamped, responsibly controlled humor magazine, and further recommend that fraternity men and Panhel (Panhellenic Council) women assume a stronger role in the production of such a magazine."

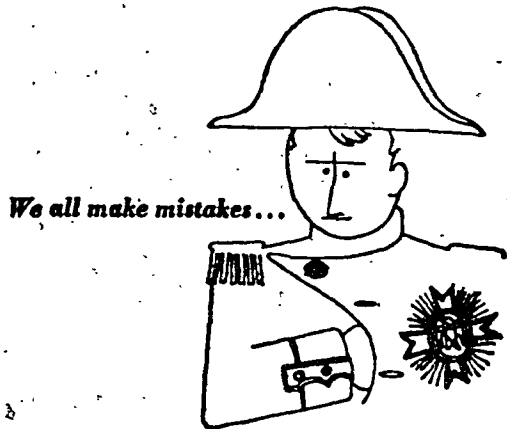
Emil Sos, president of the Interfraternity Council, said he knew about the meeting and approved of it. He would not comment on any future IFC action.
