

## University Chapel Choirs Set Schedule for European Tour

The University Chapel Choirs will make a six-week European concert tour this summer with a choral program possibly built around American composers, Mrs. Willa E. Taylor, director, said yesterday.

She said the take-off date will be June 24, and between 60 to 70 people will make the tour. The group will return the first week of August.

"Although the itinerary isn't definite yet, we hope to take in as many of the European music festivals as possible," Mrs. Taylor said.

Leonard Raver, University organist, will accompany the touring choir.

"One person will also go along to take care of the extensive educational program of the choir. In every country, we have planned special lectures and discussions on the economics and politics of that country," Mrs. Taylor said.

## Wildlife Prof Appointed

James S. Lindzey has been appointed associate professor of wildlife management at the University.

He will also serve as leader of the Pennsylvania Co-operative Wildlife Research Unit, succeeding Ward M. Sharp, who has resigned from the position.

Lindzey comes to the University from Washington, D.C., where he was associated with the U. S. Bureau of Sport, Fisheries and Wildlife. Prior to his service there, he was associated with the U. S. Department of the Interior.

## Davis Will Retire From M.J. Faculty To Accept Army Research Position

H. M. Davis, professor of chemical metallurgy, will retire Wednesday after 26 years of service at the University to accept a position as director of metallurgy and ceramics research at the U. S. Army Research Office, Durham, N.C.

Davis joined the University faculty in 1936 as a research assistant in the Department of Ceramics. He remained in that department until 1942, when he was appointed to the Department of Metallurgy. He became professor of chemical metallurgy in 1951.

During his stay at the University, Davis has conducted research work on the subject of gases in metals. His work has been supported by the Carnegie-Illinois Steel Corp. and the United States Steel Corp.

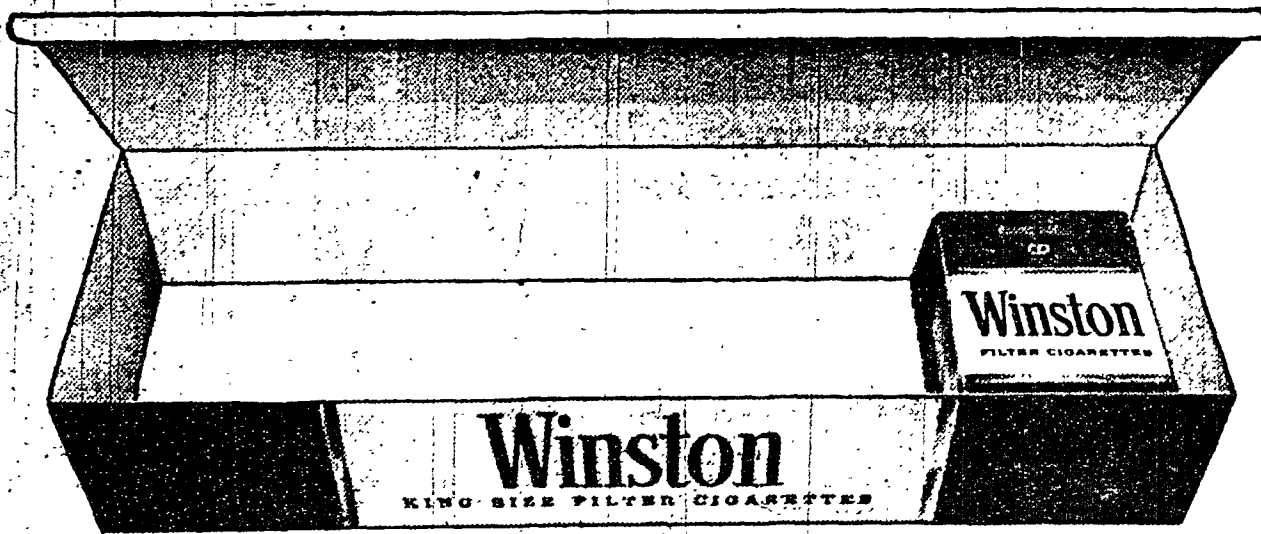
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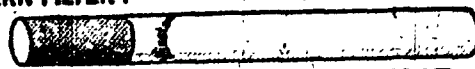
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
