

Block 'S' Club Seeks Names For Contest

The last big drive to get more names for the Block "S" Club entry in the *Monster Rally* contest will be conducted during lunch today in Waring Lounge, Deborah Eddy, co-chairman of the campaign, said Tuesday.

The deadline for submitting the lists of names to the national pen manufacturer sponsoring the contest is tomorrow, she said.

Miss Eddy said approximately 1,600 names have been collected so far by circulating the lists in residence halls, fraternities and the Hetzel Union Building.

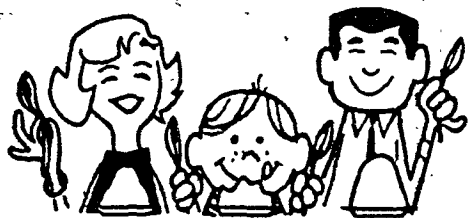

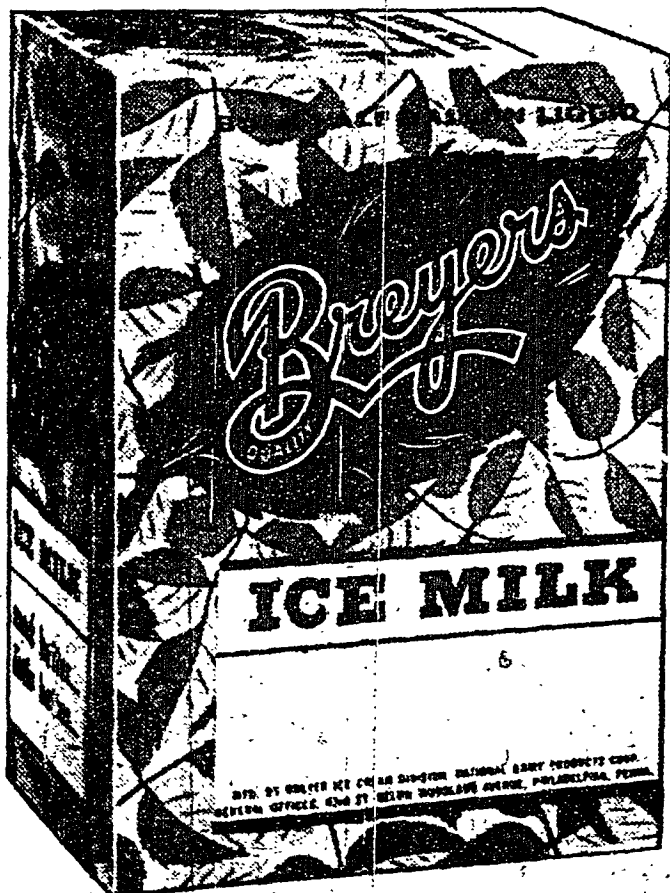
