Legislator Visits Asked by Wharton

Undergraduate Student Government President Dean Wharton suggested last night that students meet their state legislators over the Christmas vacation and tell their side of the Penn State story.

THE LEGISLATORS have taken a "dim view" in the past of protest marches and organized letter writing campaigns in support of the University's budget requests, he said. Personal contact would be much more effective, Wharton pointed out.

"The most effective way students can help the University get a good appropriation is by familiarizing legislators with University programs and the students themselves."

The next session of the legislature will open with many new members who may not be acquainted with the University, he added.

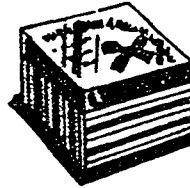

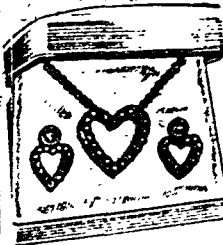
