

Group Dances at Farm Show

A full exhibition program of Bavarian folk dancing was presented Tuesday evening at the Harrisburg Farm Show by the University's Schuhplattler folk-dancing society.

The group of twenty dancers, directed by Ronald Connor, graduate student in psychology, is one of the few Bavarian Schuhplattler folk-dancing societies in the country. It specializes in renditions of Schuhplattler dances as performed in the small towns of Southern Germany.

At the Harrisburg exhibition, the group performed such

Schuhplattler standards as the Schnackelewitzer, the Fritzwendler, the Figurentanz, the Wenn der Auerhahr Baltz, and Jealousy.

During the academic year, the society represents the University at many of the nation's largest folk-dancing festivals.

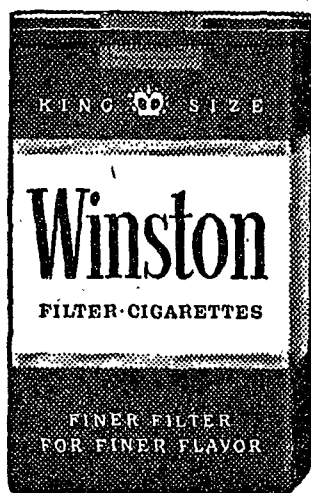
