Zoology Professors Conduct Fish Pond Depletion Study

Scientists in the zoology department are looking toward bettering the luck of the fisherman.

A study is being conducted to determine how many pounds of fish can be removed during a year without depleting a pond for future years. Evidence found during the study could supply the angler with smaller quantity but larger fish instead of a large num-ber of small fish.

EDWIN L. COOPER, professor of zoology and entomology, and George Krantz, graduate assistant in zoology, have been conducting their harvest study in a private lake owned by the Rockwell Foundation. The foundation also allots \$2,500 a year for the study.

Last year a field party removed about 70 per cent of the fish from the lake.

They found that fish, unlike other animals that will die when confronted with a food shortage and will mature at a smaller size. A large-mouthed bass for exam-




The idea of the study would be to determine at what point removal of the fish will cause a decrease in fish poundage for the coming year.

In a report containing specula-tive work for this spring, the two men anticipate "that the reduction in the fish population in the spring of 1963, after a detailed estimate of the population is completed, will approach 50 per cont

From this point, the scientists must see if the smaller number of fish will continue to grow and eventually reach the total weight of the fish in the previous large population.
