

Freedom Rider Will Speak

John Maguire, former freedom rider and professor of religion at Wesleyan University, Middletown, Conn., will speak at the 10:55 a.m. service tomorrow in Schwab. His topic will be "Waiting for Someone Already Here."

One of the original freedom riders, Maguire was imprisoned briefly in his home town of Montgomery, Ala., in 1961.

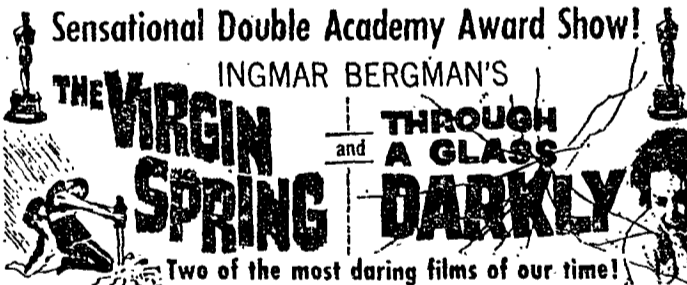
