Meyer, associate editor of The National Review.

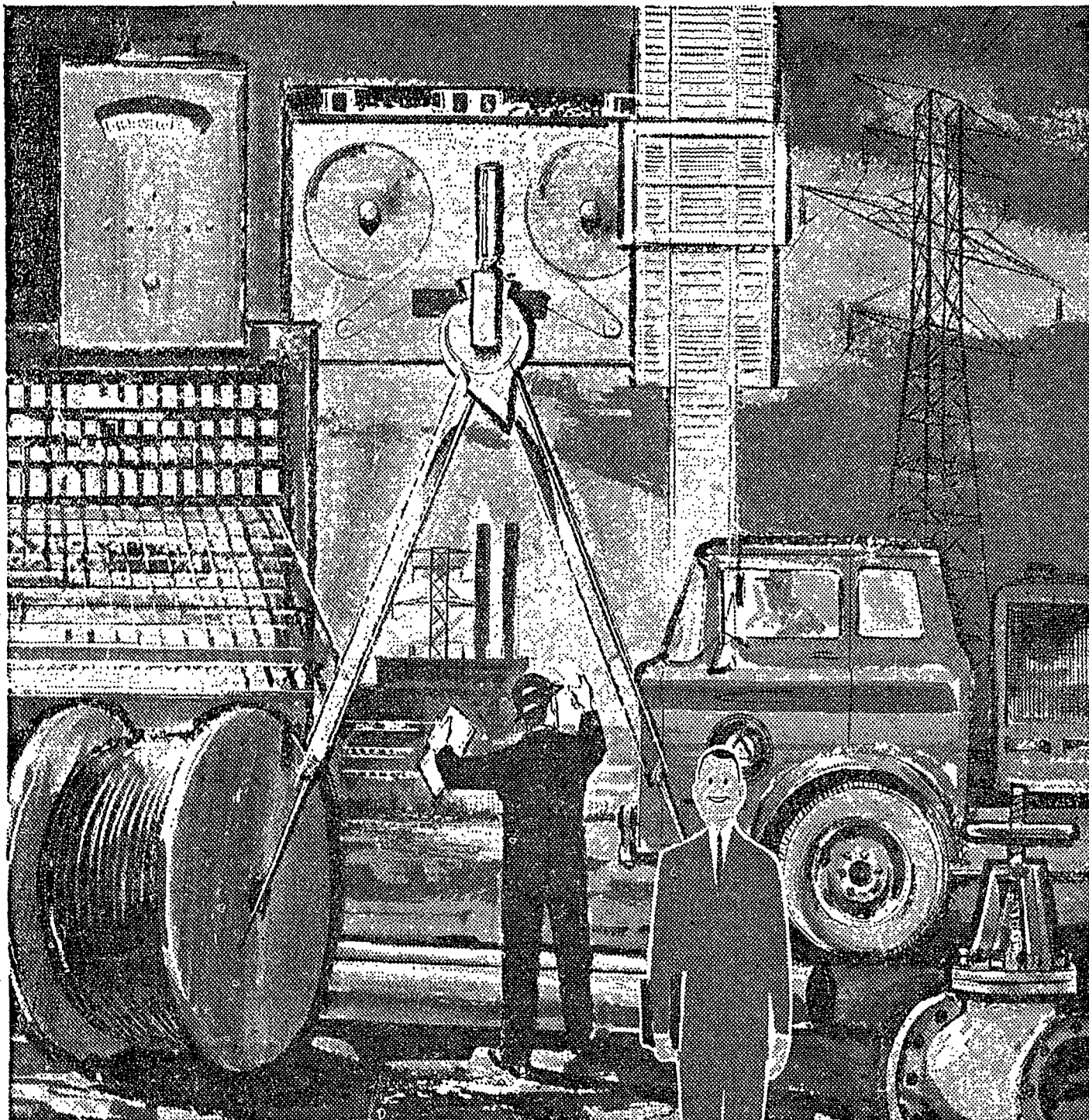
