four weeks ago, two parties nominated candidates. This amendment, Geiger said, will also clarify for the elections commission the question of whether or not parties may nominate candidates in special congressional elections.

Liberal Party Chairman George Gordon said last week he is "unalterably opposed" to this change in the elections procedures.

If the amendment is passed, Gordon continued, "Liberal party will insist on a referendum on the question of political parties and the USG constitution."

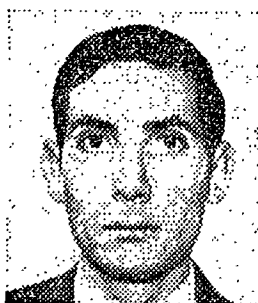

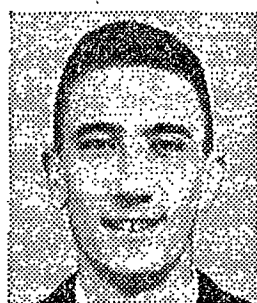

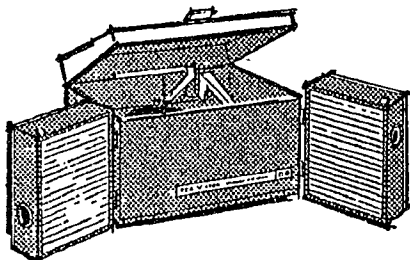
