

## University Enrolls 300 New, Transfer Students For Winter Term Here

About 300 new students, including 100 freshmen and 200 transfer students with advanced standing, have enrolled for the winter term.

In addition, about 175 students have been re-admitted to the University this term.

The total of 475 students is an increase of 95 over records for the winter term 1963.

**Began Sunday**

Orientation for the new students began Sunday and will continue until 5 p.m. today. Final health examinations, chemistry tests, swimming tests, library tours and deferred preregistration tests are scheduled for today.

An activities information center will be open from 1:30 to 5 p.m. in the Hetzel Union main lounge to provide new students with information about extracurricular activities.

The students were welcomed to the University Monday night by John R. Rackley, vice president for resident instruction,

at a reception in the HUB ballroom.

**To Err Is Human**

Rackley told the students that they should take full advantage of their freedom to make mistakes.

The freedom to make mistakes will not only help a student gain better insights of himself, he said, but will also benefit him by preventing similar mistakes in later life.

Rackley told the student they would have "rewarding years" at the University if they pursued their intellectual abilities and delved deeply into the educational community.

Success comes to students who are highly motivated and work with efficiency, he said. However, students should not overtax themselves with extracurricular activities to a point where their classroom activities suffer, he cautioned.
