## Acclaimed Organist To Appear Sunday

Tickets for Marilyn Mason's concert will be available free to students beginning at 1:30 p.m. today at the Hetzel Union Building desk.

Miss Mason, who has been acclaimed as a "master" on the organ by critics in both Europe and North America, will appear at 8:30 p.m. this Sunday in Recital Hall of the Music Building.

Her performance will include works by Bach and Walther, as well as those of more modern composers such as Messiaen and Durufle.

Students may obtain tickets upon presentation of matriculation card and certificate of registration until 5 p.m. today and between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. tomorrow through Saturday. The tickets will go on sale tomorrow at 9 a.m. and will be available through Friday.

The chairman of the department of organ at the University of Michigan, Miss Mason has been guest professor at Columbia University and at Union Theological Seminary. She was the first American woman to play in Westminster Abbey when she represented the United States at the International Congress of Organists in 1957 and has also performed in Vienna and Berlin.

At Penn State she will play "Concerto del Signor Torelli," "Aria con Variazioni," "Martini," Bach's "Prelude and Fugue in D Major," "Etude de Concert," by Van Der Horst; Messiaen's "Ver-sez"; "Scherzo," Durufle and "Concert Variations on the Austrian Hymn," Paine.

## Atwater To Discuss Vietnam Views Tonight

Elton Atwater, professor of political science, will speak on "Vietnam—Our National Crisis" at 8 p.m. today in the first of this term's "student-faculty dialogues" at the Jawbone Coffee House, 415 E. Foster Ave.

Atwater, who disagrees with the present national policy, has said he is in favor of de-escalation and a reduction of the American commitment in Vietnam. He has also emphasized a need for "substitution of international responsibility."

The dialogue will start with Atwater's considering the reasons the United States is in Vietnam. The assumptions of involvement, he has said, are three fold—"national security, ideological conflict and religion."

Atwater will also consider the four major dilemmas he feels the U.S. now faces because of the Vietnam conflict: the dangers of escalation, democratization, negotiation and unilateralism.

This student-faculty dialogue will be the first of eight to be presented this term at the Jawbone. The dialogues are designed to allow students and professors to discuss relevant issues of our time on a person-to-person basis.

Other subjects to be discussed this term include "The New Left," "The Emerging University" and "The Morals Bit."

The dialogues are sponsored by the Lutheran Students Association. Everyone is welcome to attend.

Since the order for the total number of copies must be sent to the printer this term, this week will be the only opportunity for upperclassmen, fraternities, sororities or others to order the book.

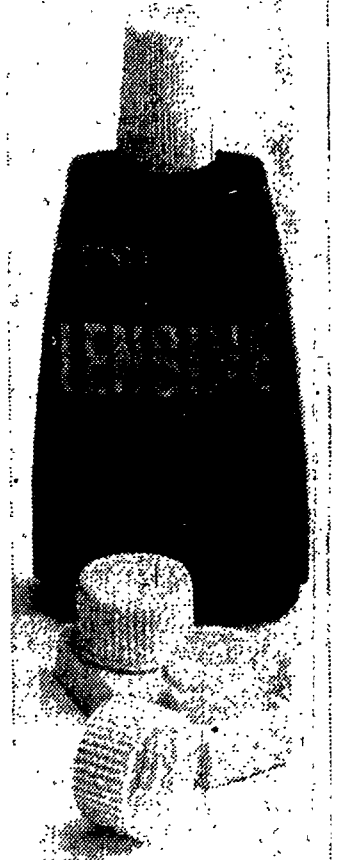
## New Plans For Unity
