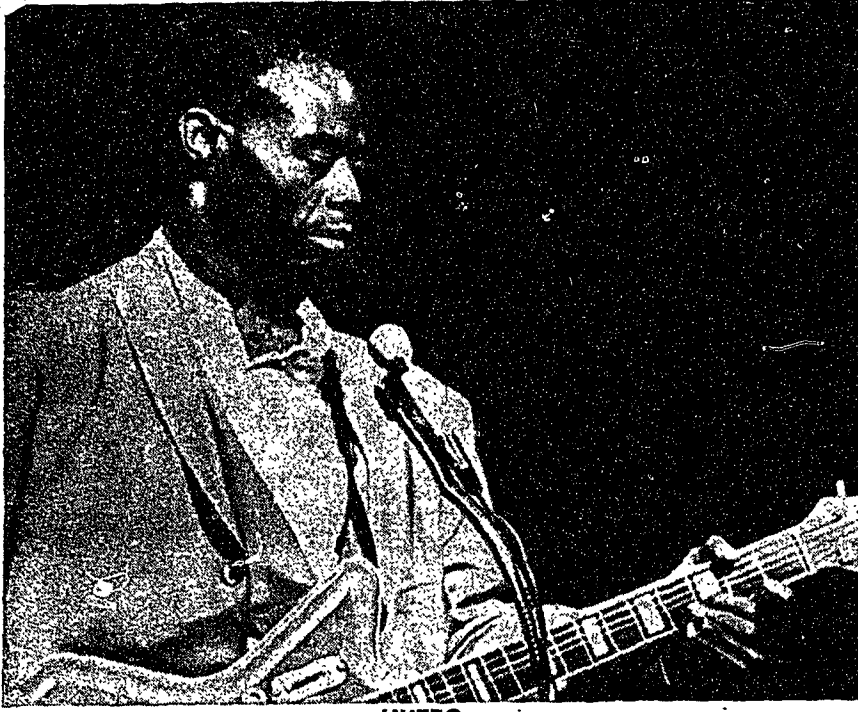
This afternoon, Tim Thomas, a member of the Student Organization for Black Unity, will speak on the "Black Student Movement."
