The chief US negotiator, PARIS (AP) - On the eve Xuan Thuy told the three-William J Porter, avoided any reference to the points still under dispute, but forth by the United States and pleaded for moderation in the modification of the substance talks scheduled to resume 30. The delegations agreed to skip next week's regular Thursday session because of Thanksgiving

Each of us is aware that the restoration of peace in Vietnam is approaching, Porter told the meeting Each of us is equally well aware of the efforts being made to refine and perfect the accomplishments of negotiation so that a settlement fair to all will result.

"It is reasonable, therefore, to expect that our deliberations in this forum be consistent with the good will and seriousness required for productive negotiations '
