BONN (AP) — Chancellor moderately right wing and Willy Brandt's triumphant favor free enterprise without Social Democrats prepared yesterday bargaining with their junior partners in the ruling coalition as the opposition Christian Democrats took stock of their crushing election defeat.

Chief government spokesman Conrad Ahlers announced that Brandt will meet Free Democrat leader Walter Scheel this week on forming a new government as soon as possible

Brandt and Scheel are fully agreed on continuing the East-West reconciliation policies for which the Nobel Prize-winning chancellor won a resounding mandate in


