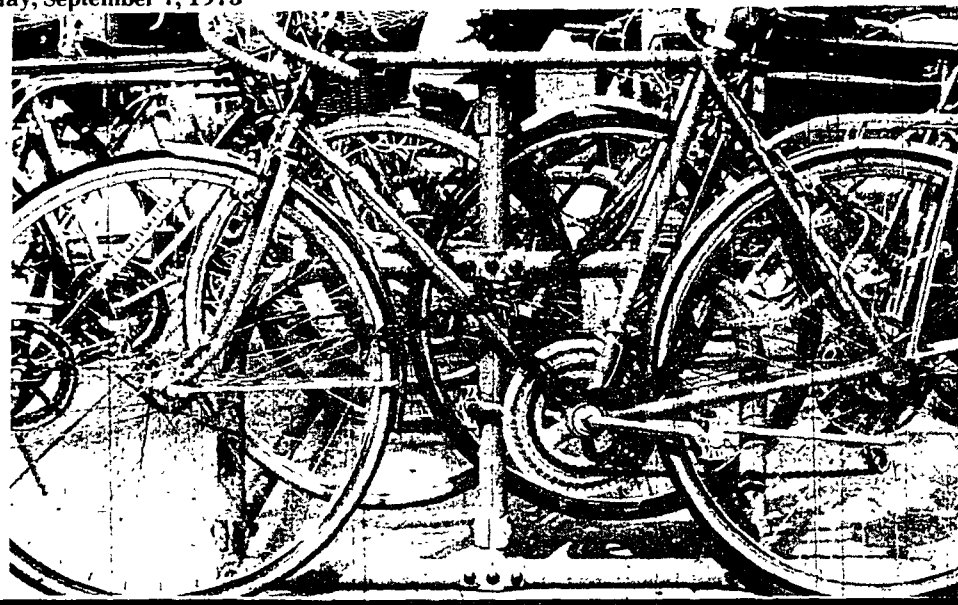


Ignorance of the law...

The Department of University Safety will hold a special bicycle registration 2 to 4 p.m. Saturday, in each dorm area. The special registration areas are: Hamilton Court, Warnock Union Building, Johnston Patio and Pollock Union Building. Bicycles can be registered any other time at the east end of Spruce Cottage. The number of bicycles stolen on campus jumped from 34 in 1971 to 152 in 1972. So far this year 79 have been reported stolen. Major Clayton

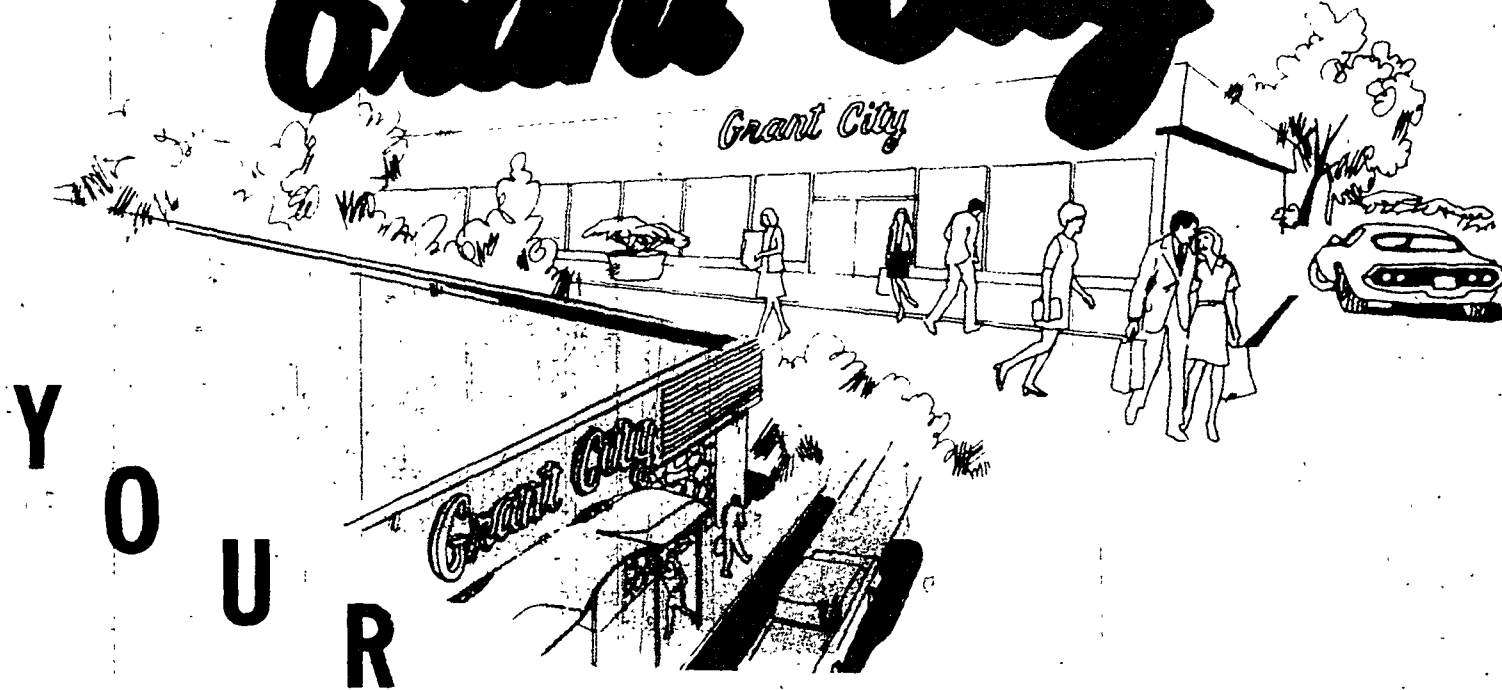
Smith, Acting Manager of Police Services, said it is important that bicycles be registered so that, if a stolen bicycle is recovered, the owner can positively identify it by the registration number or frame number, which are recorded at registration. To be registered a bicycle must be operable and have a light, a back reflector and a bell or horn. Registration on campus is a free service provided by the Department of Safety. Registration by State College

police downtown costs 50 cents. Smith said students should remember that bicycle registrations must be renewed each year. Smith said bicycle regulations, such as, not riding on paths or walkways, parking in racks when they are available and registering bikes should be followed, since warning and possibly tickets and fines later will be given to violators. Community Relations Officer Marvin Freed will provide

a copy of the regulations and fines, a leaflet announcing the special registration and a folder on bicycle security at registration. Also at registration, Freed will display types of bicycle locks, showing which are more secure. The Department of Security picked up and impounded 65 unregistered bicycles during summer term break in an effort to remove old abandoned bicycles from campus bicycle racks. He added the some impounded bicycles have been claimed.
