Colloquy used to be a "one shot deal" of speakers and workshops lasting less than a week every Spring Term. Now it is part of the Colloquy Speaker-Workshop Committee, which will offer similar programs throughout the year. The committee began because members of Colloquy and other organizations thought the University needed a coordinated speakers program, according to Colloquy President Jerry Miller.

Members of the Free University, University Union Board, Graduate Student Association and the old Colloquy staff joined to form the new committee. None of these groups had the resources to provide a good speakers program by itself, Miller said.

The committee is beginning the speaker season with a science fiction program later this month. Hugo award winner John Brunner, author of "Stand on Zanzibar," will speak on the environment 8 p.m. Wednesday in Schwab. Jerry Pournelle and Roger Zelazny will debate on science fiction 8 p.m. Sept. 17.
