## Student Affairs to start recruiting

# University prospects to get help

The office of Student Affairs is developing a new formal program designed to provide information about educational opportunities at the University and to help recruit prospective students.

The program, approved Friday by the University Board of Trustees, will be developed by a Coordinating Office of Secondary School Relations and will report to Raymond O. Murphy, vice president for student affairs.

Murphy said the office will try to strengthen contacts with prospective students, high schools, parents and guidance counselors and provide them with up-to-date information about University programs, policies and admissions processes.

As a possibility for improving service, he said having alumni and present

University students contact high school students has proven beneficial in the past and the office would seek ways to increase this contact.

"I think technology offers us many opportunities to improve relations with students and counselors through providing them with information," Murphy said.

One method for receiving detailed information about University programs is through the Listening-Learning Services in 13 Pinchot. Murphy said the center contains tapes on 42 of the 121 available majors and programs. He said the tapes give detailed information about each program, its requirements and employment trends.

This service now is available only at the University Park campus, but soon will be available at the Commonwealth campuses, Murphy said.

"It would be nice if someday every

high school in Pennsylvania could have a set of these tapes so students could find out about a specific program and its requirements from someone in the program," he added.

Murphy said the office will coordinate student recruitment by the colleges, campuses and departments and try to bring a mixture of students to the University.

Murphy said National Merit scholars, Educational Opportunity - Program students and women interested in specific career fields were among those the office would make an effort to recruit.

"This office must stress the very positive attitude and aspects of college," Murphy said.

Murphy added he hopes the office will be set up and working within the month. He said his office soon will be looking for a director for the program.

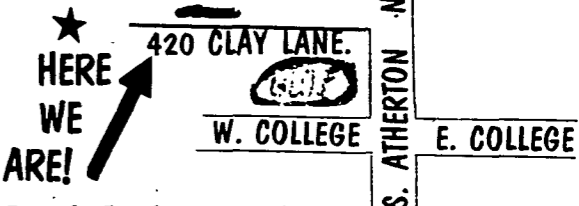
