

Feminist speaks tonight

Barbara Gittings, keynote speaker in New York's Christopher Street March this summer, will speak 7 p.m. tonight in 108 Forum on "Gay Liberation: What Ever? Heterosexual Should Know."

Gittings has been active in the lesbian feminist movement for the last 15 years. She organized the first lesbian organization in the Eastern United States, The Daughters of Bilitis. She also edited one of the first lesbian publications, The Ladder, and founded and coordinated the Task Force on Gay Liberation in the American Library Association.

She organized and participated in the first Gay picket lines at the White House and Independence Hall in Philadelphia.

Rudy, of Kent State University, said he hoped this conference would be "a modernization of 'NAACURH' and a break away from the old mold."

The first conference was held in May at West Virginia University. Both were entitled "Communication."

From Wednesday through Saturday, the delegates and advisors participated in conference meetings and workshops

formed to assist schools needing help with forming residence hall government, communicating with administrators and other problems.
