

# Team to teach course

A professor of psychology and a women's liberation activist will team up Winter

Term to teach an experimental course dealing with problems facing women today. "The Psychology of Woman," designated Liberal Arts 498 or Psychology 498, will be taught by Carolyn Sherif, professor of psychology at the University and Helen Baer, a local women's liberation activist. Funded by a government endowment from the National Foundation of the Humanities, the course

originated as an interdisciplinary graduate program. It was introduced Fall 1972 during a graduate-level psychology seminar. Ideas for the course came from student research papers. "The course is going to bring in history, economics and in general be an interdisciplinary program," Sherif said. The course primarily will feature films and speakers. Sherif said she thinks

women's courses serve an important need for women on campus. "The problems of being a woman were being ignored," she said, "and I think we must realize, first, that women are important, and second, over the years there has been a biased view towards them. "We want to build the kind of course that will make people go out and question such things as male-female relationships in politics and every other aspect," she said.

Baer said enrollment will be limited to 20 undergraduate or graduate students. Sherif said a "substantial minority" of males were represented in the women studies course last year. Course pre-requisites include Psychology 101 or 102, or a research equivalent in another department; Statistics 200 or a research equivalent; and two 400-level psychology or social science courses.

# Women's referral service offers information, advice

If you are a woman and are wondering where to find a competent woman doctor, need advice on where to go for abortion counseling or just need someone to talk to, call 355-0264.

The Women's Information Referral Service, which opened yesterday, provides information on where to go and who to call for information on services available to women in the State College area.

The service, sponsored by Women's Liberation, is set up at the home of four members in Julian.

There are no established hours, but Glorienne Leck, Women's Liberation member, said it would be better to call in the evening because someone probably would be home then.

According to Leck, the idea for the service started when women new to the area came to a Women's Liberation meeting and said they wanted to know where to get day care, doctor and birth control information.

Women's Liberation sent out questionnaires asking area women to name services which would interest them. Members then made up an information sheet, listing the phone numbers of requested services.

Leck said the service will be two-fold. First,

it will refer women to professionals for help. This includes gynecologists, female general practitioners and lawyers.

Second, the service will advise women on where to seek information about jobs, educational services and recreational activities.

Leck said the women will not try to do abortion and birth control counseling themselves but will refer women to places such as the Family Planning Center for professional help.

The service also will provide women with someone to talk to about their problems. Leck said women sometimes fight with their boyfriends, are on the verge of leaving their husbands or feel they are going to have a nervous breakdown. She said the natural urge is to grab the phone, just to talk to anyone who will listen.

The referral service will handle what it terms "women in transition." This includes women about to alter their living style by getting married or divorced, or moving to a different location.

Leck said the service is equipped to advise these women, not just refer them to other places. Leck said Women's Liberation eventually hopes to compile a complete list of referral numbers, which will be published in local newspapers.
