

Assistant Sports Editor Russ Perlman and the Lion track team will be busy with Glenn Perlman, a little road work and a homecoming this weekend.

First job is the CYO Meet at Maryland's Cole Fieldhouse tonight at 7 p.m. Then it's on the road again for a trip to Long Island, N.Y. for the Knights of Columbus Meet at Nassau Coliseum tomorrow night.
