The Raiders, who whipped Pittsburgh 33-14 last season in the AFC playoffs, had ranked first in the AFC in overall defense going into the game.

In the early moments of the third quarter, Pittsburgh drove to the Oakland 30 yard line with the help of Gilliam's 32-yard pass to Steve Davis and an 18-yard completion to John Stallworth.

However, Oakland safety Jack Tatum intercepted a Gilliam pass at the Raider one-yard line on the next series to blunt the drive.

Fullback Mary Hubbard then got Oakland out of the hole with a 13-yard burst up the middle. Hubbard finished with 96 yards on 19 carries to lead all runners.




