The first half was scoreless until Navy's Tom Panik stole the ball from Scott Matlack and booted into an open net. Goalie Dantzig had raced Panik to the ball but was late, thus leaving the net unattended.

Matt Bahr scored the first Penn State goal with 6:55 gone in the second half. Rich Reice set up the play with a pass to Bahr that was tipped by a Navy player. Bahr got to the ball and placed a powerful 18-yard kick into the left corner of the net. The game was again marked by a goalie's battle. Both Dantzig and Montgomery were proficient in the webbings as they stopped 14 and 13 shots, respectively.

Penn State waged its offensive mostly at the beginning and the end of the game, while Navy concentrated its efforts in the
