SAN FRANCISCO (AP) — Only Merlin Olsen remains from the old "Fearsome Foursome," but the Los Angeles Rams' current defensive front line looks as swift and vicious as its

celebrated predecessor. Olsen, fellow tackle Larry Brooks and ends Fred Dryer and Jack Youngblood dropped quarterbacks Tom Owen and Norm Snead four times in the Rams' 15-13 victory over the San Francisco 49ers Monday night in a National Football League game in windy Candlestick Park.

'It felt like they were flying in from everywhere," Owen said afterward.

They also ruined Snead's first performance as a 49er, hurrying him into a fourth-quarter interception that killed a late 49er rally and sealed the game for the Rams. The new "Fearsome Foursome" now has 28 sacks this season, making it the top quarterback killer in the National

"We didn't get any sacks last week against the New York Jets, so we figured we had to make up for it, somehow, this week," said Brooks, who caught young Owen twice himself


