Lion cagers face changes, tourney

**Collegian Sports Writer** From the way Penn State basketball coach John Bach is talking these days, the Lion

cagers should prepare themselves for a little old-fashioned shaking up. Bach, who will take his group to Jacksonville, Fla. Dec. 26 for the 24th annual Gator Bowl Tournament, said last evening that he'll be assuming the role of experimenter when the Lions match-up against the home town Jacksonville Dolphins on the 26th.

"The rest of this month will serve as a trial period," Bach remarked. "We're gonna be scattering our guards and forwards around a lot. We've really been hurting inside with (center Randy) Meister constantly being plagued with foul difficulty and with the way we've been getting outrebounded."

The lack of rebounding ability by people like forward Dave Angstadt, who had but one carom in the Syracuse contest, plid not particularly sit well in Bach's stomach.

"We need more rebounding at forward," Bach said. "We'll use Romel Raffin more at forward. We're really in trouble when we have to depend on (6-4 forward Kevin) Burke to get our rebounds. We need results on the backboards."

The return of 6-6 forward Chris Erichsen to active duty could help State out of its front court miseries. But as Bach said, such a situation may be a while in coming. "Chris has only been practicing with the team for four days. 'He's in a poor state of condition right now. He's in the practice stage."

Bach said more depth is needed at the guard positions.

"The guards must get more relief than they have been getting," Bach noted. "Jimmy Ouderkirk, particularly, has to get a lot more rest than he's been getting so far."

deeply into any depth the Lions may have had at forward. Everything considered, however, Bach

feels that Meister holds the key to a successful season.

"We can't win without starting center sitting on the bench," Bach said. "Now the Svracuse game was Meister's best performance so far (Randy had 20 points and 14 rebounds), although I thought he could have had a 35-point night.

"That game was a good indicator of what he can do," Bach continued. "But he has to realize that he has to be more bullish. So far, he has had an average of nine shots a gameand that is ridiculous. The ball has got to get to him more. He knows his role. You'll see progress now.

"Overall, the team has confidence that it's improving. If we can get good performances. on the backboards and on defense, we'll be alright."

Bach is hoping to come out of Jacksonville satisfied that his cagers gave it all they had in at least one contest in the two-day tourney. "If we play real well in one game," Bach said, "we'll be ready for January and February."






