Fencers top winter team, Garret: Army biggest win

Penn State fencing coach Mac Garrét did not hesitate when he heard the question.

"This team is far superior than anything I've had here," Garrét said. "The Army win (last Saturday in West Point) was one of the biggest wins ever at Penn State."

Garrét can qualify the 1975 edition of Penn State fencing in that fashion because one, his squad has the best record of any other winter male, varsity team, 5-1, and two before last Saturday, Penn State had never beaten Army in fencing.

The Lion fencers are now approximately half-way through their season and are currently facing the toughest teams on their 1975 slate.

Penn State's only defeat so far was to Notre Dame. The Irish nipped the Lions 14-13 yet Army handled Notre Dame easily 17-10 at West Point. So, last week, Penn State defeated the Cadets by the identical 17-10 score.

"That's not surprising," Garrét said. "In the Army win, 11 bouts went to 5-4. We won seven out of 11. It could have gone the other way."

"Each meet since Notre Dame has been more difficult. We almost reached the peak against Army."

In the Army contest, three of those 5-4 bouts belonged to the Lions' number two foilsmen, Ken Bohl. Bohl won all three bouts.

"From Notre Dame on, Bohl has been going up," Garrét said.

The foil team has the best winning percentage on the Penn State squad at 60.5 (75-49). Bohl's 25-12 mark is part of the

reason, but the number one foilsmen, John Corona, who has won 23 of 32 matches is the Lions' mainstay in foil.

"Corona is on a plateau," Garrét said. "That doesn't mean he is diminishing. He is just holding on his top performance."

A weak area though has been the third foil position. Garrét has tried several fencers and has finally settled on freshman Jeff Bukantz. Bukantz was 2-1 in the Army meet.

Garrét will keep his sabre squad open as five fencers continue to vie for the three starting spots. Jeff Emmel has secured the top position. Emmel's 77.8 percentage (28-8) is the best on the entire Penn State squad.

"Jeff Butterick (epee) is the most improved fencer on the team," Garrét said, "just look at his dual meet record."

Butterick is 12-2 in dual meets so far. The Centereach, N.Y. native took no prisoners last Saturday winning his three bouts by scores of 5-0, 5-4, and 5-1.

Penn State has five dual matches left before the North Atlantic Championships in early March.

The cast of foes include Temple, Navy, and New Jersey Institute of Technology.

"In this weekend's home match with New Jersey Institute of Technology, we will be facing one of the strongest sabre squads we've seen this year," Garrét said. "They will probably be as tough as Army." (Army won sabre last Saturday 4-5).

"If we can overcome Temple and Navy, we might have clear sailing the rest of the way," Garrét added.

By the way, after 16 tries Penn State has yet to beat Navy in fencing.

Gal cagers face Bisons, hope to keep hands up

Bucknell's womens basketball team has never been known to be a major power, but they have one thing going for them tomorrow night when they face the Lady Lions. Nobody knows anything about them.

It's virtually impossible to formulate a game plan against a team you know nothing about. And even though the Lady Lions know the Bisons are a weak team, they're taking no chances.

"We're not expecting this to be a difficult match," said freshman guard Pat Daley, "but we can't take anything for granted."

Unfortunately for the Lady Lions, they learned this through experience. Last year, they figured Slippery Rock to be an easy win, and wound up losing to them by 42 points.

The Penn State women will be missing Daley from the lineup tomorrow, due to a sprained ankle, and Coach Pat Meiser will probably use

Cay Baleshta and Hallie Bunk as replacements.

Meiser may also rest high scoring center Mag Strittmatter. Strittmatter, with a hurt leg, will probably play part of the game, but might be saved for tougher games ahead, especially against East Stroudsburg later this week.

The Bisons have two highly touted freshmen added to their varsity squad—guard Pam Heller and forward Debbie Brown. Returning

starters for Bucknell are Ruth Simpson and Linda Ortlieb.

"The main thing we have to work on in defense are the basics; keeping our hands up and hustling," said Daley. She said this was lacking in their 64-59 loss to Slippery Rock last Tuesday.

The Lady Lions have faced the Bisons five times previously winning all five. Last year, they defeated Bucknell 49-30.
