

Weather emptied NFL seats

WASHINGTON (AP)—Bad weather and losing records were more to blame for no-shows at National Football League games than the lifting of the television blackout at home, according to the Federal Communications Commission.

In its second annual report to Congress, the FCC said Tuesday that although there were increases in no-shows—fans who purchase tickets but do not attend—since the blackout was lifted in 1973, "there is no indication that professional football is about to become a 'studio sport'."

Congress enacted legislation prior to the 1973 season to permit local televising of a game if all seats were sold 72 hours prior to the game.

The NFL claimed during hearings on the legislation that there would be a decrease in attendance if the games were televised locally.

The FCC said the antiblackout law resulted in 86 home games being televised locally during the 1974 season, plus six of seven post-season games, including the Super Bowl.

There were 109 regular-season games telecast during 1973, plus five post-season games, while only one game was televised locally in 1972, the Super Bowl.

Actual attendance after deducting no-shows declined only 1.1 per cent in 1974 from 1973, going from 9.7 million to 9.1 million, the FCC said.

The FCC report shows that the three cities with the greatest number of no-shows were Atlanta, Kansas City and Chicago, which had a combined record in 1974 of 12 victories and 30 defeats, while the least number of no-shows were reported by Minnesota, a Super Bowl team, and Washington, a playoff club.

Pirates, Cubs try again

CHICAGO (AP)—Snow flurries fluttered over Wrigley Field yesterday, but the Chicago Cubs said that, barring more snow or extreme cold, they will play their season opener today with the Pittsburgh Pirates.

Last week's snow storm left drifts of more than a foot on Wrigley Field and a lack of clean-up time forced postponement of the opener Tuesday and again yesterday.

Temperatures in Chicago were in the 30s and light snow was forecast last night.

But a Cub spokesman said, "We will try and play Thursday unless there is more snow or extreme cold."

Rick Reuschel of the Cubs and Dock Ellis of the Pirates, defending National League East champions, remained the scheduled pitchers for the opener.

The Pirates plan a new look at first base where Dave Parker will replace slugger Willie Stargell, who has been moved to the outfield. The rest of the lineup is Rennie Stennet at second, Frank Taveras at short, Richie Zisk at third, Manny Sanguillen catching, Al Oliver and Richie Zisk in the outfield.

If weather prevents the opener with the Pirates today, the Cubs will open tomorrow against Montreal.

Lee: Don't make Jack mad

AUGUSTA, Ga. (AP)—Lee Trevino had a plaintive plea going into today's first round of the 39th Masters golf tournament.

"Don't make Jack mad," Trevino begged in mock-seriousness. "Be nice to him. Talk nice to him. Don't wake him up."

"They woke him up and got him mad in Florida and look what he did to us."

Jack Nicklaus, upset, angered and annoyed when he blew the title in the Jackie Gleason Classic, responded with authoritative victories in his next two starts.

It marked the end of hibernation for the Golden Bear and, once again, stamped him as the man to beat in this annual spring rite which is special in the world of golf.

"I could win. Johnny Miller could win. Gary Player is always tough. Lee Trevino is a great player," Tom Weiskopf observed.

"But if I was a betting man and I was told I could pick only one man out of the field, that man would be Jack Nicklaus."

Weiskopf, a front-running winner in his last start, is one of the leading contenders for the famed green jacket that goes to the victor in this storied event.

Penguins to end Blues?

ST. LOUIS (AP)—Coach Garry Young can only hope he left a lasting impression on his St. Louis Blues when they enter tonight's National Hockey League playoff game with the Pittsburgh Penguins.

If he did not, then the Blues' season is over. A Penguin victory would end the best-of-three playoff.

Young was livid after the Blues lost to the Penguins 4-3 Tuesday night, twice blowing two-goal leads in the opening of the Stanley Cup series.

"We go 80 games through the season to gain second place and then, in the first playoff game, we make these silly mistakes," he said. "They'd better have their heads screwed on right when they get home tomorrow or there's going to be some head-knocking."

What upset Young most were the Blues' defensive lapses, the last of which resulted in Pierre Larouche's game-winning goal.

But before his critical goal, the 19-year-old rookie assisted on Bob Kelly's goal with only 15 seconds left in the second period.

"No team should ever score a goal with only 15 seconds left," St. Louis goalie John Davidson said. "That was just one of the mistakes we made. We had the game, but we handed it to them. They didn't beat us, we handed it to them. We made the mistakes and they took advantage of them."
