

# Phils, Bucs grab first wins

NEW YORK (AP)—Tony Taylor's pinch double in the 11th inning scored the winning run yesterday as the Philadelphia Phillies edged the New York Mets 3-2.

Jay Johnstone had opened the 11th with a pinch walk against reliever Harry Parker, who had weaved his way out of a bases-loaded, none-out threat two innings earlier. After Alan Bannister forced Johnstone, Taylor delivered his decisive hit.

Rusty Staub's pinch double keyed a two-run rally that tied the score for the Mets in the bottom of the eighth.

Jim Lonborg had limited the Mets to one hit until the eighth when Del Unser opened with an infield single. After Jerry Grote rolled out, Ed Kranepool delivered a pinch single, sending Unser to third.

Then Staub's double scored Unser and knocked out Lonborg. Reliever Gene Garber walked Gene Clines, loading the bases, and Felix

Milidn's infield out scored pinch runner Jack Heideman with the tying run.

## 2 for Will

CHICAGO (AP)—Willie Stargell's second home run of the game broke an eighth inning tie and helped the Pittsburgh Pirates to an 8-4 victory over the Chicago Cubs in the season's opener for both teams.

After Stargell's leadoff homer, Dave Parker singled and Manny Sanguillen followed with another homer. The Pirates added a fourth run on singles by Frank Taveras and Rennie Stennett sandwiched around a sacrifice.

The Cubs erased a four-run deficit in the fifth with a four-run outburst in which the key blow was Rick Monday's two-run double off starter Dock Ellis.

The Pirates jumped into a 4-0 lead in the first three in-

nings. After a pair of solo homers in the first by Richie Hebner and Stargell, Pittsburgh got two more off Cub starter Bill Bonham in the third. Hebner was hit by a pitched ball and scored on Al Oliver's double. Stargell's single then scored Oliver for a 4-0 Pirate lead.

ST. LOUIS (AP)—Lou Brock's bases-loaded double drove in three runs and the St. Louis Cardinals ripped the Montreal Expos 7-2 yesterday.

Brock's hit capped a four-run Cardinal rally in the eighth inning after St. Louis had pushed across a run without a hit to snap a 2-2 tie in the seventh.

Tej Sizemore drove Ken Reitz home with a bases-loaded grounder in the bottom of the seventh to break the tie and give rookie John Denny his first major league victory.

Reliever Al Hrabosky nailed down the decision with two shutout innings.

Denny scattered five hits in seven innings before leaving for a pinch hitter as the Cards pushed across the deciding run.

Mike Jorgensen homered for Montreal.

## A's, 9-0

DETROIT (AP)—Jim Palmer fired a three-hitter and Lee May belted a three-run homer in his first American League at bat yesterday as the Baltimore Orioles took a 10-0 victory over the Detroit Tigers in the opener for both teams.

Palmer, bothered by a sore right elbow a year ago, retired the first 12 Tigers before Nate Colbert led off the Detroit fifth with a single.

May, making his first AL appearance since he was acquired from Houston in the off-season, belted his homer

into the upper deck in left field just inside the foul screen. It followed a walk to Ken Singleton-also making his AL debut-and a single by Tommy Davis.

Don Baylor drove in three Baltimore runs with singles in the fourth, sixth and ninth innings, and Brooks Robinson singled in runs in the sixth and eighth.

OAKLAND (AP)—Rookie Mike Norris pitched a three-hitter in his first major league appearance and slugger Reggie Jackson belted a three-run homer to give the Oakland A's a 9-0 victory over the Chicago White Sox yesterday.

Norris, a 20-year-old right-hander from across the bay in San Francisco, gave up a single to Pat Kelly leading off the first inning and a single to Carlos May in the second and a double to Kelly in the ninth.
