- 2. The adviser's authorization to register for the course(s) must be obtained before registration. For Resident Instruction courses, a Number 2 card, signed by the student's adviser, must be presented at registration. This card can be obtained from the student's adviser. For Continuing Education courses, the student must present at the time of registration a note signed by the student's adviser, authorizing registration for the course(s).
- Tuition must be paid in full at the Keller Building at the time of З. registration.
