**Take valuables home,
Safety director advises**

The Department of University Safety recommends that students living in residence halls take valuable items home during term break. David Stormer, director of University Safety, said small, valuable items such as calculators, radios, typewriters, television sets and stereos are typical items stolen from residence halls during breaks. Stormer also advised that bicycles be taken

home during the entire winter term. "If it sits outside without being used, it becomes an ideal target for theft," he said. Special precautions are taken by housing staff to prevent dorm thefts during breaks. All doors are locked and chained from the inside. Housing staff members inspect the halls twice a day for fire or water damage. Stormer said thieves do not forcibly enter residence halls but instead use keys.

"We have no idea how many keys are circulating," he said. "Usually we have no way of knowing that rooms have been entered until residents return and report missing property," he said. During Fall Term break last year 51 rooms were reported to have been entered. About \$600 worth of property was stolen. Stormer said property loss has been declining for the past three years.
