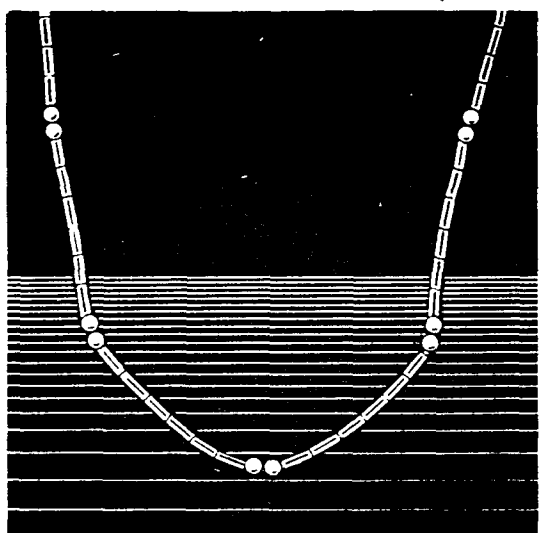

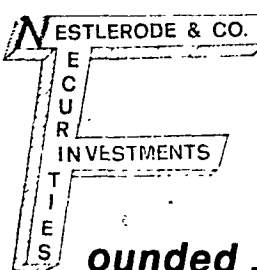
Museum of Art
