"The benefits of chloroform are minimal and do not warrant any risk, however small. The actions we propose today will eliminate any possible risk.

"I encourage drug and cosmetic manufacturers who have not done so already to discontinue using chloroform immediately, even before we complete this required legal

The FDA said its proposal was based on a report to the The proposal, subject to a FDA last month by the period of public comment, National Cancer Institute would be effective July 8 of which concluded "that chloroform induces liver human drug or cosmetic cancer in mice and renal would be allowed in interstate kidney tumors in male rats."

"The preliminary autopsy finding demonstrated that Mr. Hughes died of chronic renal disease," said Dr. Henry McIntosh, chief of internal medicine at Methodist Hospital.

McIntosh, the physician Hughes was being flown to see when he died, said the kidney had steadily deteriorated and finally refused to rid the body of wastes.






