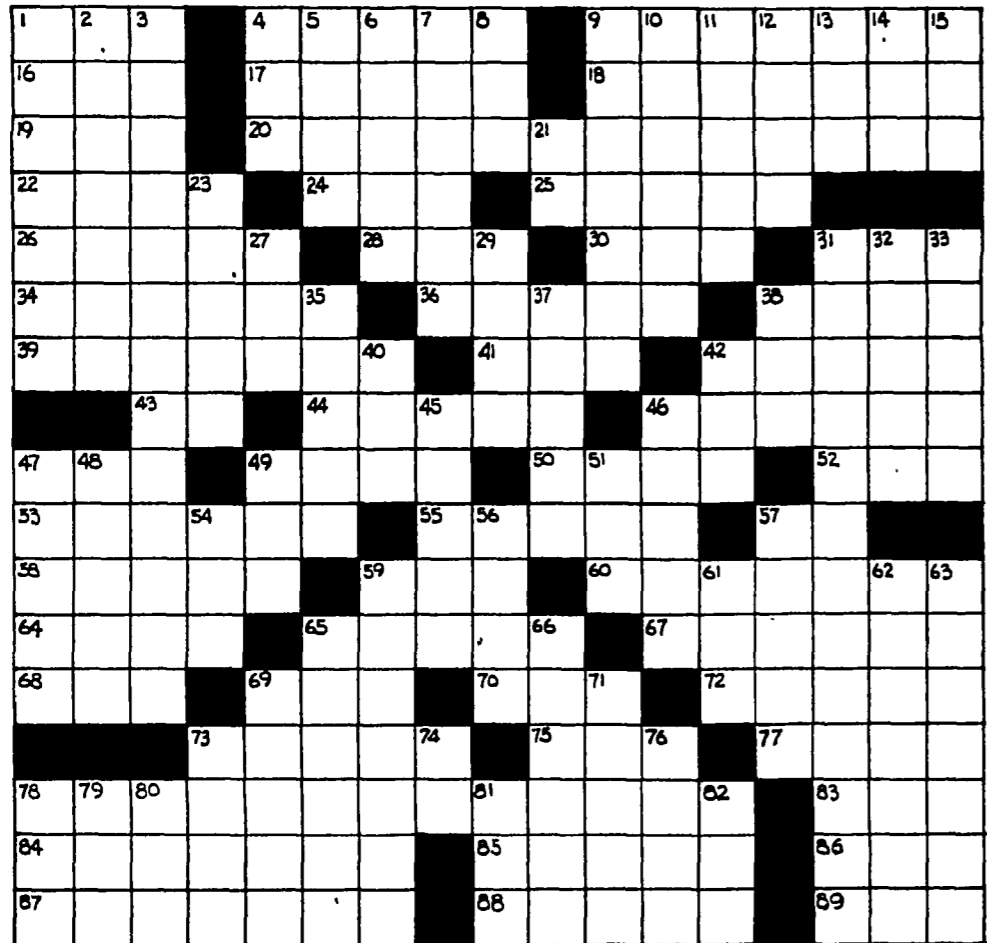

# Flaherty has high political hopes

PITTSBURGH (AP) — Mayor Peter Flaherty, a maverick Democrat with a reputation as a budget-cutting administrator, said yesterday he will not seek a third term in 1977.

Instead, Flaherty expressed an interest in running for governor in 1978 although he stopped short of a flat declaration of candidacy.

Flaherty explained his early announcement about next year's mayoral race by telling a news conference, "I

thought it was only fair, to my family and my staff and key associates, to make this announcement — since the decision has been made."

He said he wants to keep his political options open but ruled out another run for the U.S. Senate. He was defeated in the 1974 election by Sen. Richard Schweiker and reportedly considered running for Sen. Hugh Scott's seat this year, but decided not to.

"I'm not a legislator, I

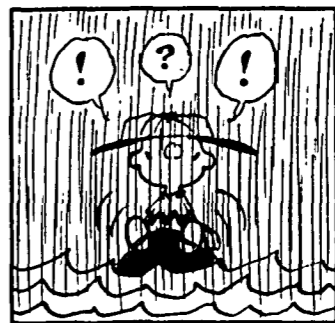
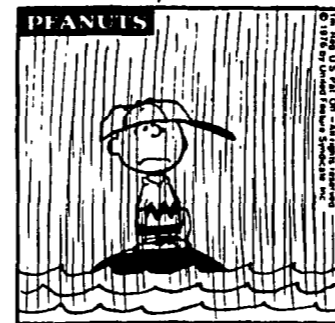
found that out. I'm not interested in the Senate," Flaherty said.

But asked about the governor's office, the 50-year-old Flaherty grinned and said, "That's something I'm interested in."

In Harrisburg, Gov. Milton Shapp said Flaherty would be a strong candidate for governor but would face a tough primary race against Lt. Gov. Ernest Kline.

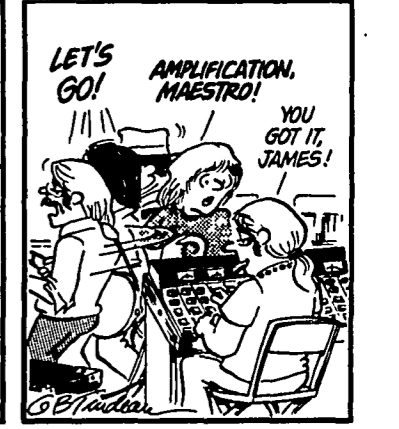
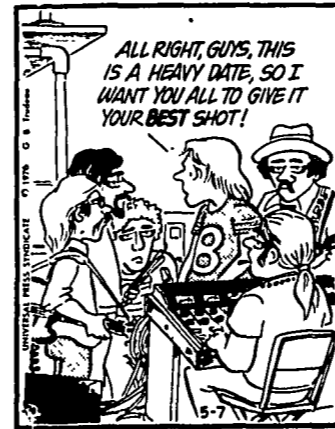
Flaherty's political future has also been linked to that of Democratic presidential frontrunner Jimmy Carter. Flaherty was the only major politician in the state to support Carter and campaign for the former Georgia governor. Carter won a major victory in that primary last week.

The mayor said he will continue to work for Carter's nomination but said he hasn't talked with Carter about the possibility of a national post for himself if Carter is elected.



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
