\$40 billion error typo erases taxes

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Rep. Sam Gibbons, D-Fla., says Congress just might have repealed the corporate income tax last year through a typographical error.

That would be a \$40 billion error - the amount the income tax on corporations is expected to raise for the government this year.

Gibbons said the Revenue Adjustment Act of 1975 mistakenly changed section "11a" of the Internal Revenue
