

Orchestra a delight

The Pennsylvania Orchestra "Shirt-Sleeve Concert," presented by Nittany Mountain Summer, performed Wednesday night in University Auditorium for a crowd of 1,100.

Pulcinella" opened the performance. The relaxed atmosphere of the concert allowed music director Maurice Kaplow to explain to the audience the suite's Neoclassic (controlled) style, one which, Kaplow says, "delighted audiences in past seasons." 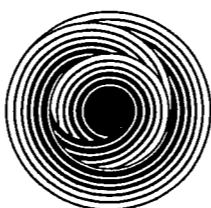
