# 'Candy's' no-hitter sweetens Buc's year

PITTSBURGH (AP) — With yesterday morning's bright sunrise, the dull grayness was gone — at least temporarily — from Pittsburgh Pirate baseball. The Candy Man made it happen.

"This is the biggest thrill I've ever had," said 6-foot-7 John Candelaria, who, on Monday night, became the first Pirate since 1907 to

throw a no-hitter in Pittsburgh with his 2-0 victory over the Los Angeles Dodgers.

But it still figures to be a dark September for the Pirates, who are well behind the front-running Philadelphia Phillies.

Yet Candelaria's left arm brought a moment of glorious relief. The noise in the Pirate clubhouse after the game attested to that.

"On behalf of the Pirates, we want to present this game ball to Candy," centerfielder Al Oliver shouted over the din.

"It was well-deserved."

added Oliver, who made the game's final out on a soft fly to shallow center.

The Dodgers managed only three baserunners all night and all came in the third inning on Candelaria's only walk and a pair of Pirate errors.

That loaded the bases with two outs before Bill Russell hit a routine bouncer to

shortstop Frank Taveras, who threw to Rennie Stennett for the force at second.

The night started sweetly enough for 10,000 fans in attendance. They were all given candy bars by a local firm as a special "Candy Night" tribute.

After the game his Pirate teammates laid a path of white towels, dotted with

candy bars, from the locker room door to Candelaria's dressing stall.

He was aware even then that he had a no-hitter going. "I knew it from the first inning," he said. "A pitcher has to know."

Bill Robinson's two-run double put the Pirates ahead to stay in the fifth off losing pitcher Doug Rau.
