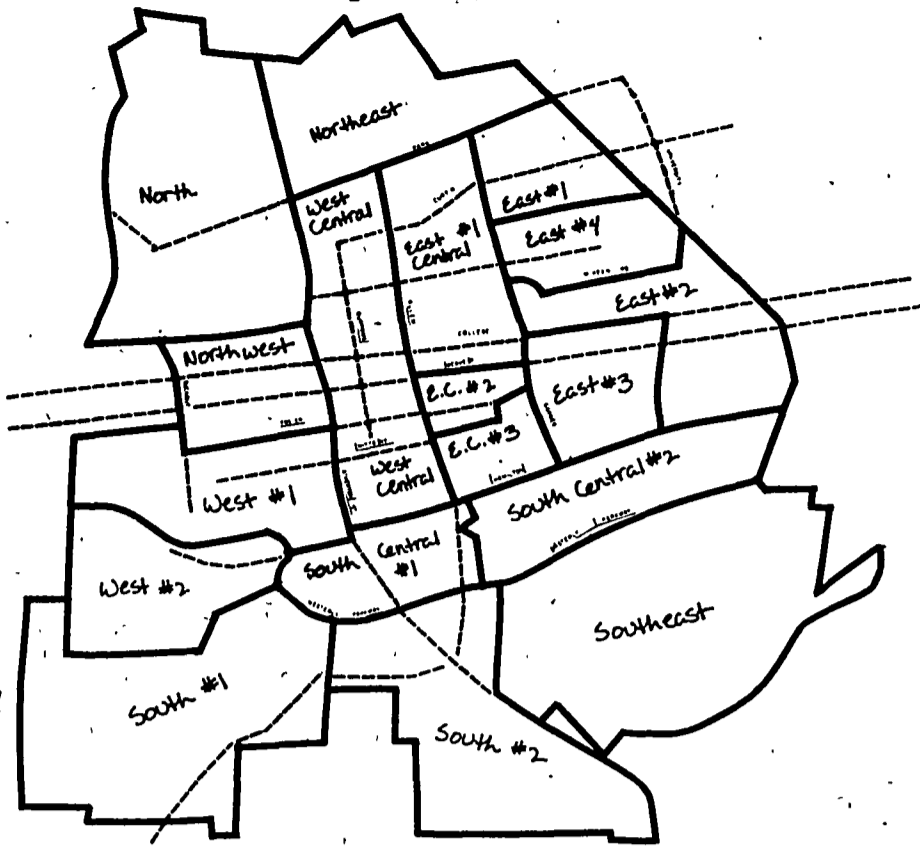


Where, when and how to vote; you decide who



Today is election day, and confusion over where to vote should not keep students who want to vote from exercising this right.

WHERE DORM RESIDENTS VOTE

- Students who live in Pollock-Nittany, Mifflin, Hartranft, McElwain, and Beaver residence halls vote in room 23 of the Pollock Union Building.
- Students living in South Halls and Simmons Hall vote in Stevens Hall Rec Room.
- Students in North Halls and Atherton Hall vote at the Wesley Foundation, 256 E. College Ave.
- Students in East Halls, except those in Snyder, Stuart, Stone and Hastings Halls, vote in 118 Wagner Building.
- Students in the four excluded dormitories vote at the College Township Municipal Building.
- West Halls residents vote at Rider Oldsmobile Garage, 121 S. Burrows St.

WHERE TO VOTE FOR STATE COLLEGE DISTRICTS

- North: Social room, Church of Christ, Martin Terrace
- Northeast: College Heights School, N. Atherton Street
- South 1: Westerly Parkway Junior High School

SAMPLE BALLOT

General Election held on the second day of November, 1976

Mark a cross (X) in each box in the column to the right of each candidate for whom you wish to vote. If you desire to vote for a party, mark an X in the box in the column to the right of the party name. Do not mark more than one box in any column. Write your name in the space provided for that purpose. All your votes shall count equally. Use the same amount of ink for all markings you make on the ballot.

NOTICE: Before marking the voting compartment, read the ballot, without displaying the markings thereon, to the same eye it was issued when the right hand corner of the back of the ballot is folded so that the markings are not visible to the voter. If you are unable to read the ballot, you may request the election officer to read the ballot to you. The election officer shall read the ballot to you, but shall not indicate to you the name of the candidate or the number of the candidate. Any ballot displayed in a public place at any primary or election is void.
