the skin require a silicone rubber capsule which has to be removed surgically. "Another attribute of the absorbable pellet is its density," Gupta said. "A lot more

hormone can be packed into a smaller space.' He said a pellet containing hormone to prevent a human pregnancy for two to three years need be only one centimeter long or .39 of an inch compared to the 15 to 20 centimeters (roughly 6 to 8 inches) for a silicone rubber capsule large enough to do the same job.

Gupta said the pellets are made by fusing together a widely used oral contraceptive hormone called dnorgestrel with minute amounts of pure cholesterol, a natural component of human fatty tissue.
