

# Softballers shaded in season opener

A sacrifice fly by Faye Lawrence scored Debbie Sanders from third base Saturday to break a 2-2 deadlock and give Temple a 3-2 victory over the hosting Penn State softball team.

Temple had jumped out to a 2-0 lead in the fourth inning. Mary Decker led off the inning with a single and advanced to second on a ground out. Sue Smith singled to drive home Decker. After a walk to Cindy Cohen and a force out at third, Paula Montoney singled to drive in Cohen.

The Lady Lions came back to tie the game in the sixth inning on back-to-back home runs by Pam Hoyes and Janet Scinto. However, Temple came back in the seventh with a triple by Sanders and then the sacrifice fly by Lawrence.

Both teams had threatened to score earlier in the game. In

the second inning, Decker got a single off of Lady Lion starter Debbie Malone and moved to third on an error by centerfielder Diane Dixon. Decker was not trying to score on a passed ball, but Malone was not yet out of hot water.

Lady Lion coach Pat McTarsney was disappointed at her team's performance, but still felt it was a good game. "I'm just sorry the score wasn't reversed," she said.

McTarsney was disappointed in her team's hitting performance and indicated the Lady Lions would be doing a lot of work in that area. "We didn't start hitting early," the coach said, "and it could have been better when we did."

McTarsney was pleased with the home runs by Hoyes and Scinto. "I'm not surprised they hit them," she said, but added that it was unusual to have them back-to-back.

The Lady Lion coach said Temple is having already played three games was a "big factor." It has to be an advantage to have some games under your belt, she said.

In the junior varsity game, Temple trounced the Lady Lions, 11-7. Temple had 10 hits while the Lady Lions had only six. Mary Decker led Temple with three hits and Val Vecchio had two for the Lady Lions.
