# Goal-hungry laXwomen at home

Brockport (N.Y.) will probably score a few goals today against Penn State on the women's lacrosse field by East Hills, but it is unlikely the visiting New Yorkers will have much more success than the Lady Lions' last victim, Millersville.

Penn State, in its season opener last Thursday, blanked Millersville, 21-0, as Charlene Moret poured in eight goals and goalie Jody Field needed to turn back only three Marauder shots.

Brockport is not a Division III school as Millersville, and it did win an informal New York state championship last year against Ithaca, Cortland and Colgate.

And even goalie Field, who probably could have blanked Millersville without

using a stick, said, "I'm sure they'll be more of a challenge than Millersville."

But so ends the contrast of opponents. Brockport has several strikes against it that will make the going rough when the opening draw occurs at 2:30 today.

For openers, it's Brockport's first game of the year, and the colder weather up north has severely limited its practice time.

Second, New York does not have the high school lacrosse system that Pennsylvania does. Many of Brockport's lacrossewomen didn't learn the game until they entered college.

Finally, last year's New York championship team is cut in half, due to graduation. Even Brockport coach Gwen Steigelman called her squad enthusiastic, but inexperienced.

Steigelman does have three returning

attackers, and the brunt of the scoring load will fall on them: first home Nancy Hebblethwaite, second home Cheryl Clifton, and right attack wing Eileen Beuler.

For Lion coach Jill Rattray, her high-powered offense relies heavily on scoring wizards Moret and Sharon Duffey. Morret added four assists against Millersville for 12 points, while Duffey collected seven goals and three assists.

Moret, Duffey, and attackers Chris Larson, Karen Schellenbach, and Sue Wisniewski should get plenty of action.

But for Field, with an unsung defense of Linda Waltz, Karen Brethrick, Donna Mallen Cynthia O'Donnell, and Karen Jones in front of her, it may be another boring afternoon protecting the Penn State goal.

# Reese sets up Aliquippa v-ball win

A couple of pretty fair basketball teams met on the volleyball court last night at the intramural building.

More likely, it was some errant Aliquippa spiking coupled with some first-rate Potter hitting that gave Potter, now 2-1, its second game conquest.

For Aliquippa, now 4-0, it's on to a showdown with Ogontz this Thursday to determine the League E championship. — Bill Kline.
