enthusiastic, but inexperienced. Steigelman does have three returning attackers, and the brunt of the scoring load will fall on them: first home Nancy Hebblethwaite, second home Cheryl Clifto, and right attack wing Eileen Beuler.

For Lion coach Jill Rattray, her highpowered offense relies heavily on scoring wizards Morett and Sharon Duffey. Morret added four assists against Millersville for 12 points, while Duffey collected seven goals and three


