OAK BROOK, Ill. (AP) — Tom Watson fired a 69 yesterday to win the Western Open Golf Tournament by one stroke over Johnny Miller and Wally Armstrong with a five-under-par 283.

At one time on the last nine of the demanding Butler National course, Watson's lead was shared by Miller, Armstrong and Tom Weiskopf.

Miller and Armstrong finished with 69 and 70, respectively, to share second place.

Sneva Schaeffer victor, Andretti a close second

MOUNT POCONO, Pa. (AP) — Tom Sneva, driving a smooth, consistent race, held off teammate Mario Andretti by 1.75 seconds for victory in yesterday's \$400,000 Schaefer 500, which was marred by a serious crash involving Mike Mosley.

who was trailing Sneva by more than a lap, a chance to make a pit stop without losing any more ground. He passed Sneva to regain the leader's lap just as another yellow flag came out. That allowed Andretti to close up behind Sneva for a five-lap dash to the finish.

Mosley plowed into the second turn wall only a few laps from the finish. He was rushed to the hospital semi-conscious, and in stable condition.

Andretti had a sizable lead over Sneva when fading brakes caused him to overshoot his pit area on the 161st lap. He had to go around the 2½-mile track again, and lost a lap.

Mosley was running in 11th place when his Lightning racer broke loose, slammed into the second-turn wall and bounced into the infield. The crash gave Andretti,

Sneva, who led the rest of the way, drove a steady pace and got consistent work from his pit crew — something he didn't get in the Indianapolis 500. It cost him the race there.

The victory in the second leg of the Indianapolis-type racing's Triple Crown moved the 29-year-old Sneva, winner of two previous U.S. Auto Club Indy car races, into the lead for the national championship.
