## Less rigid pot laws possible in spring

**Daily Collegian Staff Writer** Marijuana may be decriminalized in Pennsylvania by the time University students leave for sylvania by the time University students leave for spring break, according to Bill Cluck, legislator educator for the Pennsylvania chapter of the National Organization for the Reform of Marijuana Laws (NORML).

Cluck said House Bill 904, which makes the possession of small amounts of marijuana a \$50 fine without a criminal record for the offender, is in the

without a criminal record for the offender, is in the Pennsylvania House Judiciary Committee. He said if the bill leaves the committee, which is almost certain, it will reach the House floor.

Once on the floor, the bill needs 102 votes to pass. Cluck said at present 80 votes for the bill are almost assured. He said he'is optimistic that enough uncertain legislators could be swayed to help pass the

In order for the legislators to be swayed, Cluck said, they must be convinced their constituents favor the bill. He said anyone interested in having .

the bill pass should write or even visit their representative. At present, Cluck said he is the only lobbyist for the bill.

If the bill makes it through the House, Cluck said, he is confident the state Senate will pass it. Right now 20 of the necessary 26 votes in the Senate are almost assured, he said. Once the bill is through both Houses, Gov. Shapp is certain to sign it, he said.

One problem Cluck foresees for the bill in the House is the voting of legislators from the "Bible Belt" of the state, which is every county except Philadelphia, Allegheny, Bucks and Centre coun-

He said legislators from the belt must represent the opinions of their constituents when voting on the bill. People in the belt generally have gross misconceptions about marijuana and other emotional issues, he said.

One legislator who is certain to vote against House Bill 904 is Joseph Zeller of Lehigh County. Zeller said he feels decriminalization would

"open the door for the use of marijuana." He added that decriminalization would psychologically allow younger people to say marijuana is legal.

Another House member who undoubtedly will vote against the bill is Martin Mullen of Philadelphia. Mullen said he doesn't think marijuana is a good thing and he wants its use stopped. He said a deterrent to marijuana abuse would be a stiff penalty. "A kid will think twice before using it if there is a \$300 fine," he said.

Helen Wise, the House representative from the 77th district, favors decriminalization. However, she isn't very optimistic about the bill's chances. "In the rural areas, marijuana is a very controversial issue," she said.

Wise, who said she would like to see the bill go through, is concentrating most of her efforts on the funding for higher education, she said. Wise also said if the marijuana bill goes through, the bill to lower the drinking age probably won't even reach the House floor.

County, said he also would support the ( decriminalization bill but isn't in favor of saying the use of marijuana is permissable. Zearfoss also said there are some problems with the bill. One problem he mentioned concerned the acquisition of pot. If dealing is illegal under the bill, how can someone legally obtain marijuana? he asked.

According to Cluck, decriminalization as a concept means the elimination of criminal and civil penalties. However, because peoples' attitudes change slowly, criminal but not civil laws have been 3 changed in the states in which decriminalization has passed. In about 10 or 15 years, NORML may try to eliminate civil penalties, he said.

Cluck added that, realistically, there always will be a black market for marijuana, whether it is legal, illegal or decriminalized.

If the decriminalization bill doesn't pass the House, Cluck said, there is a similar bill in the state Senate which would then become the focus of NORML's efforts.
