Italy may be cut off from NATO

BRUSSELS, Belgium (UPI) - The North Atlantic Treaty Organization would withhold defense secrets from Italy if Communists become part of the Italian government, diplomatic and defense sources said Tuesday.

NATO Secreatry General Joseph Luns said earlier it would be "extremely grave" if Communists became ministers of defense, foreign affairs or interior.

Although NATO has not expressed a collective view on the problem, one diplomat said Luns was expressing the opinion of "everyone around here" — that NATO would still be able to work with a government including Communists.

'There is, as you know, a big difference between participation and a takeover of a government," Luns said.

He cited the experience NATO already has had in the case of Iceland and Portugal, which for a time included Communists in the cabinet.

"There's a heck of difference between Italy and Iceland," one NATO source said, pointing out that Italy is a permanent member of NATO's Nuclear Planning Group which coordinates Western nuclear strategy under American leadership.

Portugal was a non-permanent member of the Nuclear Planning Group at the same time it had a quasi-communist premier - but it averted a crisis by tactfully staying away from Nuclear Planning Group meetings.

It would be harder to exclude Italy from NATO defense planning, alliance sources said, because of its key role on Europe's southern flank and the presence of nuclear stockpiles.

cleared" to hold 75 behicles, with a section reserved for compact cars.

Another idea proposed is to experiment with peripheral parking. Longterm parkers would park away from the downtown area and take public transportation to it. The only peripheral location considered was on University land, behind the intercity bus station, but the University wasn't too enthusiastic about the idea, McClure says. No major parking problems exist in State College's residential areas. Even though many student vehicles are only employees given convenience

parked for long periods of time, Fair-banks says, residents have been able to find enough parking. Vincent P. Norris, a member of the State College Traffic Commission, says more requests are received for parking bans in residential areas than for more parking.

At the University, enough parking exists for the University's 15,500 registered student, faculty, and staff vehicles. The only problem is that of convenience parking, according to David E. Stormer, director of the Department of University Safety. The spaces, Stormer explains, are those who must occasionally use their vehicles for work-related purposes.

"No attempt is made to meet the convenience needs of everyone,' Stormer says. "Parking on campus is quite fragmented. However, there's generally enough space to provide for the activities as regularly scheduled."

Stormer says stricter enforcement policies on campus eased the convenience problem. During the 1973-74 academic year, when students and employees were parking in convenience spaces instead of assigned lots, more

than 62,000 violation citations were issued. But during the 1976-77 academic year, only about 19,500 violations were issued.

"More are voluntarily complying," Stormer says, "while the Campus Loop bus system has also helped."

The real problem affecting downtown State College exists 365 days a year, and is expected to become more acute in the next five years. Since five years of planning will be necessary before a new parking garage can be built, the State College Parking Task Force recommends planning begin immediately.
