To be used during emergencies Water systems get another link

A pipeline connecting University and borough water systems is being installed on S. Burrows Street, David A. Long, chairman of the State College Water Authority said.

The pipeline will create an additional connection between the campus and town during emergencies, Long said.

"Under normal conditions the valve would remain closed but could be opened under extenuating circumstances," he said. "For example, if there were a fire

either in town or on campus, we would open the valve to increase the water supply to firemen."

Lloyd Niemann, spokesman for the University's Office of Physical Plant, said the pipeline could be used only for one-way water flow because of the differences between campus and town systems.

"Because the two systems are gauged at different pressures water flowing through the pipeline will have to be pumped," he said.

"We would be unable to install a connection for a two-way flow, causing us to leave the valves closed except during emergency situations," Niemann said.

Long said the pipeline is a cooperative effort between two systems to improve University and borough effectiveness during emergencies.

"It's something we've been planning for a number of years," he said. —by Tim Konski

Sadat invites pope to visit Egypt after signing of peace agreement

VATICAN CITY (AP) — President Anwar Sadat has invited Pope John Paul II to visit Egypt and pray on Mount Sinai after the signing of an Egyptian-Israeli peace treaty and the pope has "expressed a great interest," Egypt's ambassador to the Vatican said yesterday.

Shaffie Abdel Hamid, the ambassador, declined to give any further details. "I'm a diplomat, I can't quote the pope," he said.

In the Cairo newspaper Al Ahram, Egyptian Deputy Premier Fikry Makram Ebeid was quoted as saying "the pope has accepted the invitation."

A Vatican spokesman, however, said the press office had no information about the report.

President Sadat also invited Popes John Paul I and Paul VI to visit the site located in the Sinai Peninsula, which has been under Israeli occupation since 1967.

Mount Sinai in the Old Testament is where Moses received the Ten Commandments from God. Sadat wants to build a mosque, church and synagogue there when Israeli troops withdraw in compliance of the Camp David peace accords.

Ambassador Hamid said the invitation was extended by Ebeid during an audience on Monday. John Paul met

with more than 100 foreign delegates who attended his installation as the 264th Roman Catholic pontiff the day before.

The late John Paul I had several times in his brief 34-day reign asked for prayers for the success of the Camp David summit talks of the leaders of Egypt, Israel and the United States.

John Paul I's predecessor, Paul VI, visited the Holy Land in 1964.

Mount Sinai is revered by Moslems, Jews and Christians. Located on the northern slope is the monastery of St. Catherine, one of the oldest of the Mideast's Christian shrines.

John Paul, the first Polish born pope, has also expressed the desire to travel to his native land next year. He voiced his hope Monday during an audience with

1,000 countrymen and 3,000 other visitors of Polish descent who had come to Rome for his installation.

The Vatican also announced that the 58-year-old pontiff will travel by car today for a brief visit to Castel Gandolfo, the lakeside town south of Rome. Pope Paul died at the papal summer palace there Aug. 6 at the age of 80.

Yesterday, the new pontiff held a series of audiences with cardinals scheduled to return home and received Italian President Sandro Pertini, who was making a courtesy call to the Vatican.

Pope John Paul also announced his first two appointments, naming Italian bishops to diplomatic posts in Senegal and the Congo.
