

Women swimmers face East Stroudsburg today

Stroudsburg in a dual sprint meet at 3:30 today in the Natatorium.

The Lady Lions, who are 6-1 on the season in dual meet competition, will be trying to enter more team members in the Easterns in short distance events. The closing date for qualifying times for the Eastern Association of Intercollegaite Athletics for women is next Tuesday.

"We're hoping to get a qualifying time in the 200-yard freestyle relay since it's the last short meet at home," coach Ellen Perry said.

East Stroudsburg was the only team to beat the Lady Lion freestyle

The women's swim team hosts East relay team last year. This is the tenth meeting between the two teams and Penn State's record is 5-4 in the series.

> Defeating East Stroudsburg. however, shouldn't prove too difficult since they have lost their top swimmer to graduation. Also, East Stroudsburg lost to West Chester, a team the Lady Lions easily defeated, 101-30.

"Our focus tomorrow is to keep working on our sprint times and qualifying," Perry said. "The score is secondary."

Lady cagers expect easy victory in quest for top spot in regionals

The women's basketball team, in its quest to secure a top bid in the regional playoffs, should have no trouble helping its cause when it hosts Millersville at 7 tonight in White Building.

Millersville, 6-4 on the season, has not competed against any top 20 teams. Their latest decision was a 74-67 victory over Army Monday.

First-year Marauder coach Lynda Humpreyville, who came to Millersville after coaching a junior varsity high school girls' basketball team in Texas, expressed uncertainty as to her starting five. Possible starters include senior

Deb Hudson and sophomore Vicki Kendig in the backcourt and forward Mary Kay Conahan.

Michelle Savino, a junior transfer from Montgomery Community College, often comes off the bench.

"We're just going to give our best,' Humphreyville said. "I know they've (Penn State) done really well."

Last year Penn State easily downed Millersville, 81-49. Jen Bednarek paced the Lady Lions' victory, scoring 16 points. Penn State has taken nine of 10 games from the Marauders since the series began 10 years ago.

Penn State, 16-6 and ranked 11th in the coaches' poll, needs to win their remaining games to be seeded either second or third in regionals. As of now, Cheyney would be seeded No. 1, while No. 4 Maryland, No. 9 Rutgers, and Penn State are fighting for the No. 2 and No. 3 seeds. Seedings will be announced Feb.

The first-seeded team will play the eighth-seeded team and No. 2 faces No. 7 at either the University of Maryland or the University of Delaware. The

The wrestling team has been going through a frustrating season, losing all of its eleven dual meets. A win would surely minimize some of the pain, but if the Lions are to notch that initial victory they had better hurry.

Tonight's meet with Lock Haven at 7:30 in Rec Hall is the team's final home contest, and Saturday's meet with Pittsburgh will be the season finale.

While Lock Haven is currently in last place in the Eastern Wrestling League with an 0-4 record, it has compiled an overall record of 10-10. The Lions, 0-3 in the conference, are preparing both mentally and physically for the Golden Eagles.

"We have to put everything that's happened behind us," Lion coach Rich Lorenzo said. "We have to prepare for them just the same as we did for Lehigh, or any other team."

Lock Haven is certainly not lacking when it comes to experience and talented wrestlers.

The Golden Eagles embarked on a tenmatch midwestern road trip earlier this year in which they faced tough competition in Indiana, Cleveland State, and Nebraska. Of those 10 matches, Lock Haven registered four victories.

Leading the way for Lock Haven this year are two upper-weight wrestlers. Junior Tim Thompson at 190 pounds

owns a 16-4 record, while junior heavy weight Gregg Koontz, has compiled an 11-3 slate. The 290-pound team captian also has 38 career pins.


Thompson and Koontz will be pitted against the Lions' Sam Sallitt and Jim Sleeper, respectively. The remainder of Penn State's lineup will be the same one that faced Lehigh Saturday.

Geoff Brodhead, who gained two of the Lions' nine team points against Lehigh with a last-second reversal to earn himself a tie, will need another super effort tonight. He will meet Lock Haven's Dave Moyer (14-4) who won the Golden Eagles' own Mat-town, USA tournament in the 142-pound bout.

In the 158-pound match, it will be a battle between two freshmen. The Lions John Hanrahan, who ended a personal six-match losing streak in the Lehigh meet, will face Joe Baranik (9-6).

"We're going to need 100 percent from each guy," Lorenzo said. "We can't think that they're going to lay down for us.'

Following tonight's match, the Lions will travel to Pittsburgh at 1 p.m. Saturday, and return there on Feb. 24 for the Eastern Wrestling League Tournament. The top two place winners in each weight class will then advance to the National Collegiate Athletic Association national championships at Iowa State.
