## Democrats lack judge candidate

The Democrats still have found no one to oppose Charles C. Brown Jr. in the election for Centre County Common Pleas Judge, the Democratic area chairman said Wed-

The Democratic candidate for prothonotary will be incumbent Ruth C. Rudy. The prothonotary keeps Common Pleas Court records. Rudy said she increased the county's revenue during her term.

Mike Krehel of Bellefonte is the first Democratic candidate for coroner in 20 years. Krehel has been a licensed funeral director for seven years, and has had experience working with the coroner.

John W. Miles will run for an eighth term as recorder of deeds. Miles has held the position since 1952.
