Under extenuating circumstances, as in your case, a student may not have to take the required swim test. Regardless, the physical education department strongly encourages students to take it, for their own sake.

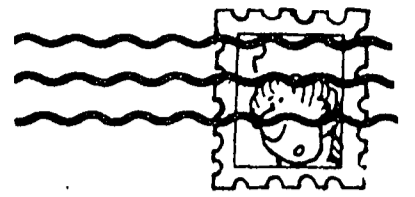
Grin and Bear It
