Lasagne Supreme

INGREDIENTS
4 cups tomato sauce (or more if vegetables used)
8 oz. (1 pkg.) whole wheat lasagna noodles
1 lb. ricotta or cottage cheese or tofu
1 cup grated Parmesan or Romano cheese
8 oz. mozzarella
1/2 cup walnuts

DIRECTIONS
Prepare tomato sauce per directions over. Prepare noodles per directions on package. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Put a thin layer of sauce on the bottom of an 8x12 baking dish, then build lasagne in layers: noodles, sauce, ricotta, mozzarella, Parmesan. Repeat until done, topping with a layer of sauce and a sprinkle of walnuts and Parmesan. Bake about 40 minutes. Allow to cool a bit for easier cutting. Serves six.
